- Continued to spark an interest in budding engineers during our **Engineering** is **Elementary** monthly hands on **Homeschool Classes** sponsored through a grant by the **The Joe W. and Dorothy Dorsett Brown Foundation**
- Hired a new WINGS Director and Assistant Director who were able to introduce over 200 school-aged children to the performing arts in our WINGS program
- Entertained and educated more than **750** campers in our **Summer Camps**
- Hired an educator who continues to share with preschoolers and their caregivers the joy of literature in our early childhood education program,

- Built a new outdoor deck, "The Gathering Place," where weddings, performances and programming can take place in an outdoor setting funded by the Tidelands Trust Fund
